MADRASAH ALSAGOFF AL-ARABIAH

Madrasah Alsagoff Al-Arabiah embarked on 1:1 student iPad learning environment to deepen teaching and learning since 2011. MADRASAH ALJUNIED AL-ISLAMIAH

Madrasah Aljunied Al-Islamiah is the only Madrasah worldwide to be listed as an International Baccalaureate (IB) school. With the training and exposure from IB programme, students will develop inter-disciplinary, inquisitive and critical skills to become future religious scholars and leaders who are critical and compassionate thinkers.
